## Gerard Bringmann – Chair, LIRRCC

MTA Board Appointment: June 2021  
Appointed to LIRRCC: January 2001  
Recommended by: Suffolk County Executive

Gerard Bringmann was appointed by Governor Andrew Cuomo to a seat on the MTA Board representing the Long Island Rail Road Commuter Council (LIRRCC) following confirmation by the New York State Senate. He commutes daily from Patchogue on the Montauk Branch to his job as an Interiors Superintendent in Manhattan. An active member of his community, Mr. Bringmann is currently the Health and Wellness Chairman of Suffolk Region PTA and will become the Chair of the Permanent Citizens Advisory Committee to the MTA (PCAC) on July 1, 2021. He previously served as the chairman of the LIRRCC for four years, the vice chairman of the LIRRCC for 2 years, and as the PCAC second vice chairman for two years.

Mr. Bringmann received an Associate Degree in Applied Science degree from the State University of New York at Farmingdale.

He is married with three children and nine grandchildren and has been commuting on the Long Island Rail Road since 1982.
